Overall purpose

Aim of the Role: To give 600+ unique women the opportunity to play Soft Ball Cricket this summer in a fun and social environment.

- Provide clubs with 'on the ground' support to help engage more women in cricket participation
- Be the face for Women's Soft Ball Cricket across Sussex
- Deliver a series of cricket activation sessions within clubs and other organisations to enthuse and engage a new female audience to cricket
- Be part of the Women's Soft Ball Cricket Festival team to deliver high-quality cricketing festival experiences
- Work with non-traditional partners to establish new markets for the women's game
- Leverage the power of social media and the Kia Super League to increase interest and engagement around the events in the county
- Be innovative and creative exploring new opportunities for growth in nontraditional formats, by developing tailored programmes to inspire people to take part informally
- Complete appropriate monitoring and evaluation in line with funding requirements; including online monitoring platforms and finance return tools
