Increase to national RRP £50.00 per programme



All Stars Cricket clubs and centres will receive £15 per participant. (£5 increase from the 2023 model).



Dynamos Cricket clubs and centres will receive £35 per participant. (£10 increase from the 2023 model).

For every registered participant, clubs and centres will receive £5 online shop credit. This is the same as in 2023.






