



All Stars and Dynamo's Cricket Activator Checklist

New Activator Checklist

Activators who are brand new to the programme. In order to appear as an activator at a centre they should be invited to become an activator and access training via their checklist.

Checklist Item	Details
DBS Check	Activators should have a valid ECB DBS system. Your Club Safeguarding Officer or County Cricket Board representatives will be able to activate this for you.
Activator eLearning	New Activators should complete the Activator eLearning, which will then need to be completed every three years. The eLearning consists of four modules that cover off the philosophy of our programmes as well as practical advice on how to run sessions in a fun and safe environment. The content supports what you will be taught at the face-to-face training, and you can do a bit, save, and come back to it.
New Activator Virtual Induction	Once you book onto this seminar, your local County Cricket Board will send you a link to a zoom or teams meeting to complete this part of the training. The session should last around an hour to an hour and a half and will cover off the less practical elements of the course. This will be stuff like safeguarding and how to find resources and session plans, as well as learning about how you can deliver sessions.
New Activator Face to Face Course	This session is delivered face to face and will be all about the activities and experiencing some of the games and activities that you will deliver in your All Stars or Dynamo's sessions.
Safeguarding Training	Safeguarding training ensures you have the knowledge and information to run safe sessions for all children. If you have already completed the ECB's Safeguarding and Child protection training (known as Safeguarding Young Cricketers) this checklist item should already be completed. For those that have not we have a National Programmes Safeguarding Module that can be completed by following the link on your checklist item.

New Activator Face to Face training course
Face to face training course, for all new activators, delivered by your local County Cricket Board

Safeguarding Training
Activators should complete either our National Programmes Safeguarding module or the ECB Safeguarding Young Cricketers training.

Hide checklist

The safeguarding Training item should turn green automatically if you have an existing ECB Safeguarding Young Cricketers Qualification. If not you can follow the link to create an elearning account and complete the online module that will be there alongside your National Programmes Elearning. If you have already signed in to elearning (above) the "Create Account" button should disappear.

Click "Create Account" to set up an ECB Elearning Account. Once created this will allow you to click "Take the Course" which will take you to your elearning account to complete training

By Clicking on either of these options you will be taken to our booking page which will allow you to book on your county's Virtual Induction and local face to face courses. Your Virtual Induction should take place before you attend Face to Face training



Existing Activator Checklist

Activators who have completed training previously and the centre has designated them as delivering in 2022. Activators should log onto their ClubSpark account and complete any items outstanding.

Checklist Item	Details
DBS Check	Each Activator should have a valid and up to date DBS. Your club safeguarding officer can support you in organising this.
Activator eLearning	All activators were asked to complete the updated eLearning in 2021. If you were unable to complete this last year, please follow the link on your checklist. There is a requirement to complete this element every three years.
Existing Activator Refresher Video	This video replaces the virtual refresher seminar that was delivered in 2021 and will be refreshed on a yearly basis. Activators can access the video via the link on your checklist.
Safeguarding Training	This checklist item will be marked as complete if activators have an up-to-date ECB Safeguarding Young Cricketers qualification or completed the eLearning in 2021 which included this element. If marked as incomplete, activators can complete the National Programmes Safeguarding module by following the link on your checklist item.
