Role Purpose

To support the South Area Territory Manager in the delivery of our Countywide Strategic Plan for recreational and community cricket, with a specific focus on supporting the growth and development of Women & Girls cricket in line with the Sussex Cricket Foundations 4 year ECB W&G Action Plan.

Key Responsibilities:

- Deliver and support the strategic county plan for recreational and community cricket, working closely with the South & North Area Territory Managers/Teams.
- To help support and develop W&G Cricket in the South & North/Mid Areas, focusing on:
 - Increasing number of clubs running W&G Cricket
 - o Increasing number of female only All Stars & Dynamo Cricket centres
 - \circ ~ Increase the number of female volunteers in the game e.g. coaches, umpires, scorers
 - \circ ~ To deliver school/community sessions through our Chance to Shine programmes
 - Providing opportunities for W&G to access the game
 - o Supporting facility development at clubs to ensure welcoming environments are created
 - o Grow the game amongst underrepresented groups such as the South-Asian community
 - To coach, deliver and lead events specific to W&G Cricket e.g. competitions
- To support the Foundation W&G Strategic Lead on delivery of our ECB W&G Action Plan working closely with staff in other 'Territories'.
- Delivery against Key Performance Indicators such as:
 - o ECB 4 year W&G Action Plan
 - o Participation levels in clubs, school/club transition
 - o Chance to Shine Schools/Street Programmes
 - o Lord Taverners Wicketz Programme
 - o Primary & Secondary School Competitions
 - o All Stars & Dynamos Cricket including Bursary Programmes
 - Paid Coaching Income
 - Workforce (inc. Officials, Coaches, Volunteers etc.)
- Capture visual evidence (photos/film) of sessions in adherence with media consent requirements for promotional and M&E purposes.
- Identify and record individual or group case studies for promotional and M&E purposes.
- To prepare reports on areas of work as directed by the Territory Manager or Community Cricket Director.
- To attend meetings that are linked to projects managed or meetings that will be of benefit to your role.
- To support the Sussex Cricket Ltd. Commercial Department in helping create a fanbase for the Sussex Womens Tier 2 team.
