Mental Health & Wellbeing

The circumstances we are facing on mental health & wellbeing:

- Each year one in 4 of us experience mental health problems
- 75% receive no treatment and do not know where to turn to find help
- Searching for health-related information was UK's 5th most common internet activity before COVID.
- COVID -19 has exacerbated this issue through increased isolation, health anxieties and stress over job losses.
- The platform is about helping people to take the first step towards addressing these issues





The Sussex Cricket Mental Health & Wellbeing Platform

The partnership with Frog Systems will give Sussex Cricket access to a technology driven platform that:-

- covers a comprehensive range of topics including abuse, addiction, anxiety along with care and support,
- signposts users automatically to the nearest support or service based on post code, age, and gender
- is the first on the market which links the search to a Champions Cinema library of c3,500 videos featuring the stories of real people who have had issues giving a positive message of hope and support
- encourages people who are struggling to take first step in seeking support.
- provides access to the platform through the Sussex Cricket website and/or through the club website

The platform has the full and active participation of the Sussex Partnership NHS Foundation





The Sussex Cricket Family

For the Sussex Cricket family and our communities:

- This platform will offer for the first time a technology driven link between Sussex Cricket and all its 182 affiliated clubs providing information and communication opportunities.
- Offering us an opportunity to demonstrate a significant role within our communities assisting those with mental health and wellbeing issues
- the aim is to encourage those who have stories to share to participate in the videos to be created for the Champions Cinema on the Sussex Cricket platform
- Frog will provide webinar training sessions to clubs in the use of the platform
- We would ask that you promote the platform and its use to members and families in your club
- The plan is for a November launch of the platform

Sussex Cricket will be a market leader in recognising the need to address mental health & wellbeing in the world of cricket





REVIEW OF 2020

- August Cup designed to replace the lost 2020 season, offering all
 Clubs five competitive matches, based on location and broad ability.
- Format confirmed as 40/40, generating massive participation.
- 343 teams in SCL in 2020, representing 143 Clubs.
- 254 teams entered August Cup, representing 120 Clubs.
- 74% of teams entered, 84% of Clubs.
- 41 groups of six teams, 1 group of eight. 635 fixtures scheduled.
- 42 group winners played 21 play-off matches on 5/9.
- 12 surviving A/B Group winners played neutral site play-off finals on 12/9
- Congratulations to Eastbourne 1s and St Matthias 1s, who won 7 INSPIRING A matches out of 7!
