






#### Sussex Cricket Mental Health & Wellbeing Platform in association with Frog Systems 'Finding Hope & Support through the Lived Experience"

- Platform to be launched on Monday 18th January
- We will become the first sports club in the world to launch its own, bespoke mental Health & Wellbeing Platform
- Working with Frog Systems who have developed through £1.8m of investment the first dedicated mental wellness video platform
- Partnering with Sussex Partnership NHS Foundation Trust -Seal of Approval by NHS



#### Why now?

- Each year one in four of us experience mental health problems
- 75% receive no treatment nor know where to find it
- Prior to the pandemic searching for health-related issues was already the 5th for internet activity
- The current situation with Covid-19 will exacerbate this through increased anxiety
- The platform does no offer medical advice, but the aim is to encourage people to take the first step in seeking support.


- Easy to use and to search
