Reduce Expenditure & Seek Funding Support

1. Reduce Expenditure

- Reviewing Finances*
- Reduction / Deferral of Rent
- Grounds
- Insurance Business Interruption
- Communicate
- Club Matters

2. Explore Government Support

- £10k grant for businesses* with rateable value <£15k - <u>Rates</u>
- £25k grant for businesses* with rateable value £15- £51k
- Contact Your Local Authority
- Sports & Rec Alliance

3. Seek Other Grants / Fundraising

- Sport England: <u>Community Emergency Fund</u>
 £3-10k grants
- Grants Online
- County-Wide Funds Active Essex
- Club Fundraising
 - GoFundMe / Just Giving
 - Virtual Quizzes / Race Nights









ECB Emergency Loan Scheme*

Aim

- Supporting affiliated Clubs by funding shortfalls in essential day to day running and maintenance costs until recreational cricket activity can resume.
- Loan is to cover costs and is <u>not to be used to replace surplus income</u> foregone in-year*.

Eligible Costs

- Utility/Services, Rental charges, Affiliations
- Staff costs (not coaches or players)
- Cleaning or maintenance commitments
- IT licences, Security, Insurance
- Equipment orders that can't be deferred/ recovered.
- TV/Broadband Subscriptions (if not suspended)
- Any other reasonable fixed and/or contracted costs

How much can a club apply for?

- Club with a Junior Section* between £1k £5k
- Club Adult only between £1k £3k
- All loans interest free and have an automatic payment holiday until May 2021
- Loan term is three years. Early repayment permitted.

ECB Return to Cricket Grant Scheme*

<u>Aim</u>

- To provide cricket clubs and leagues with assistance in <u>exceptional circumstances*</u> –
- Where other potential sources of financial support are not available

Eligibility

- Explored other sources; inc. Emergency Loan
- Clubs prevented from taking loan constitutionally
- Clubs with annual turnover <£15k*
- Cricket Leagues (open age/junior)

Eligible Costs

Same as Emergency Loan – fixed costs, not forecasted income

How much can a club/league apply for?

- Clubs with junior section up to £3k
- Clubs with adults only up to £1k
- Cricket Leagues up to £2k

How can we apply?

 Contact Sussex – if eligible, application to be completed & referred to ECB RFPM for assessment.
