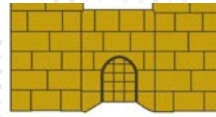


Finance and Facilities

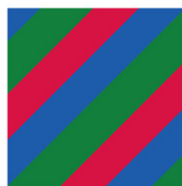
