- 1. Set up your All Stars or Dynamos Programme on ClubSpark
 - □ If you are a new centre/club please register at <u>https://ecb.clubspark.uk/</u>. See link below 'Register your club' for more guidance.
 - □ Ensure your programmes are set up correctly in ClubSpark, whether this be an 8-week programme or holiday camp.
 - □ Check that activators and administrators are set up correctly on ClubSpark.
 - □ Ensure the 'Key club contact' details are correct and updated on profile.

2. Complete ClubSpark Checklists – Club and Activators

- □ Ensure your club checklist is completed. Each criteria will show a green tick once completed.
- □ Encourage all activators to complete their own checklists in time for when delivery starts. The status will show as Approved or Completed for each criteria.

□ Ensure you have completed Stripe verification to enable your club/centre to receive programme credit in the online shop. If your account is not verified your club/centre will not be searchable on the registration postcode finder on the national launch date.

- □ Access club/centre equipment and credit and order for your programmes.

Kindly be aware that we expect shortages in stock from March to June 2024. We encourage the use of existing centre kits wherever possible to support those centres with the greatest equipment needs during this period.
