



REFUND POLICY

Sussex Cricket operate a no refunds policy. However, you may still be eligible to re-use your ticket as per the below conditions. Please check your ticket against the below criteria:

Specsavers Championship and Royal London One Day Cup:

Paid tickets – in the event that a game is not complete (as per ECB match regulations) or cancelled, there will be no refund. Paid tickets will be valid for, a future Specsavers County Championship or Royal London One Day Cup game in 2018 subject to availability.

T20 Blast:

If play is restricted or does not take place at the ground on the day for which this ticket is valid, you may claim a refund of only the match ticket value subject to there being: 9.5 overs or less of the headline match of the day because of adverse weather conditions and no result is obtained - a full refund. In no other circumstances can money be refunded.

Or:

Paid tickets will be valid for a future T20 Blast, Specsavers County Championship or Royal London On Day Cup game in 2018 subject to availability.

PLEASE NOTE: You may not use the original ticket for entry for a future match. This ticket must be returned to the ticket office and a new ticket issued. For T20 Blast fixtures, the replacement ticket issued will be "best available".

Refunds will be paid by Cheque only, with a £2 administration fee deducted.

Australia Tourist Match

If play is restricted or does not take place at the ground on the day for which this ticket is valid, you may claim a refund of only the match ticket value subject to there being: (a) 15 overs or less because of adverse weather conditions and no result is obtained - a full refund; (b) 15.1 overs to 29.5 overs because of adverse weather conditions and no result is obtained - a 50% refund. In no other circumstances can money be refunded.

We would also then deduct an admin fee of £2.
