TRAVELLING TO THE 1ST CENTRAL COUNTY GROUND...

BY CAR:

The 1st Central County Ground is located in the heart of Hove. The best way to obtain the most accurate directions is to use <u>CLICK</u> <u>HERE</u>. The postcode for is BN3 3AN.

CAR PARKING

There is no parking at the 1st Central County Ground for this concert.

There is a public car park, Norton Road Car Park (BN3 3BE), located a short walk West of The 1st Central County Ground opposite Hove Town Hall (charges apply between 8am and 8pm). There is on-street parking, although this is very limited due to residents permit parking.

BY TAXI:

There are three major taxi companies in Brighton and Hove:

BY BUS:

The Number 7 bus runs past the North (Cromwell Road) end of the ground with several stops near the ground. This service is the George Street, Hove to Brighton Marina service and serves both Hove and Brighton Rail Stations. This bus runs approximately every 10 minutes.

The 21 & 21A Brighton Marina to Goldstone Valley service stops outside the main entrance to the ground; these are less frequent but do run through the central Hove and Brighton areas.

Several buses stop at Palmeira Square which is just 280m from the ground For up to date information on these services and for detailed route map information please <u>CLICK HERE</u>

BY TRAIN:

Hove Railway Station is a ten-minute walk to the ground (800m). Leave the station and head South on Goldstone Villas, at the bottom of the road turn left onto Eaton Road. Cross over The Drive continuing along Eaton Road, The 1st Central County Ground will appear on your left hand side. Look out for the brown and white directional signs on street lights etc.

Brighton Railway Station is approximately twenty-minute walk from the ground (1600m). There are regular rail services from Brighton Station to Hove Station. There is also a taxi rank located just outside Brighton Station, together with a bus terminus (please see bus details below).

SECURITY

BAG POLICY

Please try to bring a bag no larger than A4 piece of paper. All bags are subject to a bag search; so please avoid bringing a bag where you can as this will speed up your entry to the concert.

FOOD AND DRINK

A full range of food and drink concessions are available within the venue and the fan village. Do not attempt to bring food or drink into the venue, as it will be confiscated.

You may bring 1 sealed bottle of water per person max 500ml. If you have a medical condition such as

diabetes, then a doctor's note will permit diet-specific food and drink only.

There will be a range of catering to suit all tastes, traditional hog roasts, Pie & Mash to Greek Souvlaki, Pad Thai, Angus burgers & Quiche and Salads.

There will be a variety of confectionary offers, bean to cup coffees, speciality teas and sweet & savoury crepes. Vegan, vegetarian, dairy free and gluten free offers will be available.

A full range of drinks will be available around the site to include a variety of Alcoholic and non-alcoholic

Pimms, Prosecco, Gin & Tonic, Cocktails and Harvey's Ale bar are just some of options the available

Please note that free drinking water is readily available around the site.
